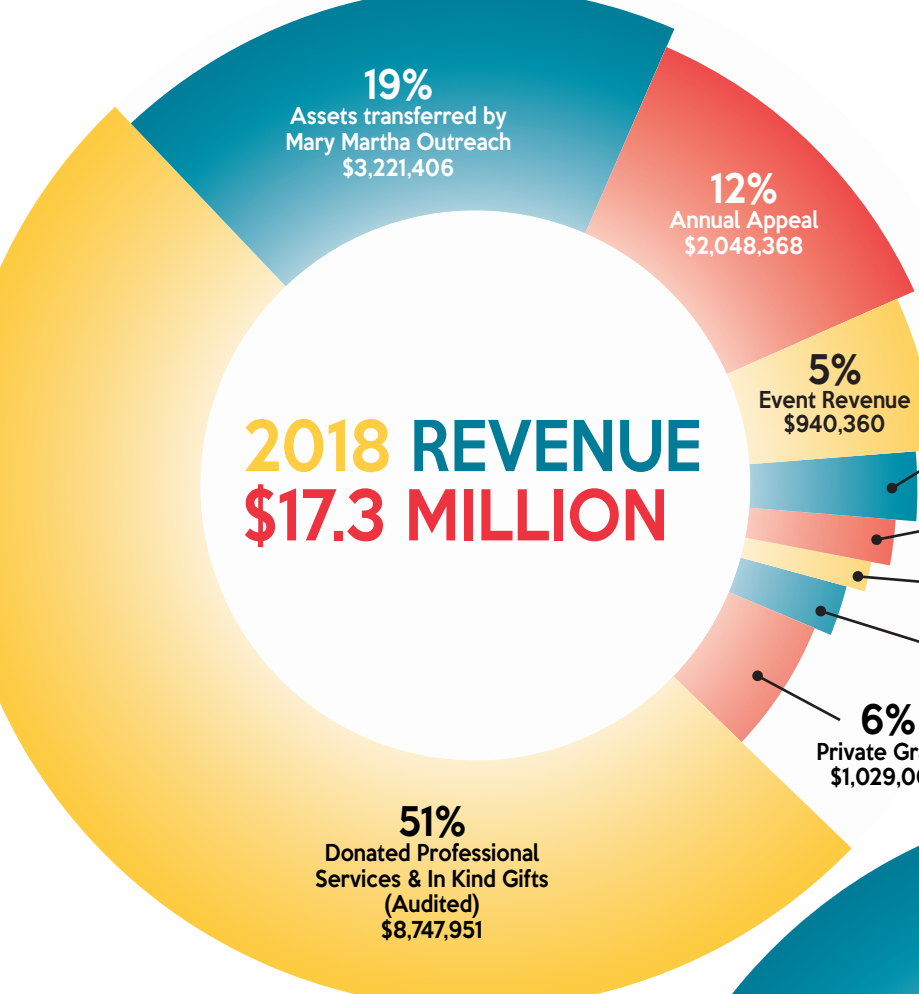

Through their compassion for others, our volunteers are love changing lives!

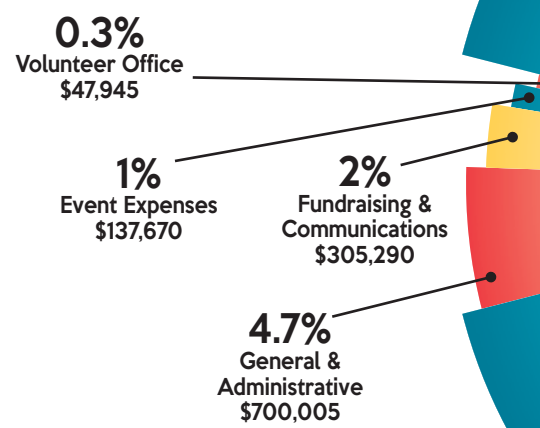
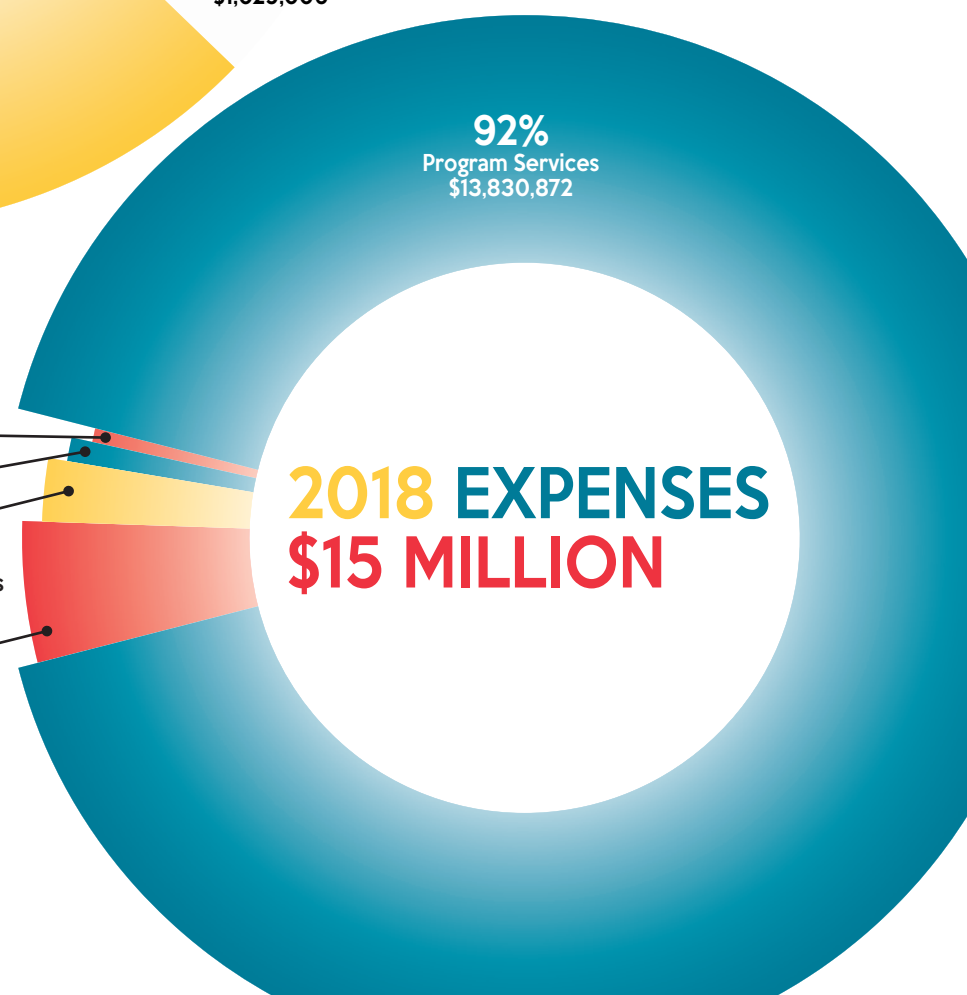
With 56 full-time and 24 part-time staff members, our volunteers almost double the impact we have in our Eastern Oklahoma communities.
