# WEEKEND OF OCT. 5 & 6 | ANNUAL APPEAL WEEKEND

Please put a sufficient number of BROCHURES IN THE PEWS for each Mass. Have ushers or other volunteers replenish the brochures between Masses and, if it's not too much to ask, place a brochure every few feet in the pews and remove any brochures which have had the envelopes torn off.
