

## **CC McAlester Volunteers Fill Community Need**

The employees and volunteers (staff) of Catholic Charities McAlester have settled into their new space, now located in a 4,000 square foot building at 503 S. 2nd Street near downtown McAlester.

"We love it," said Eastern Oklahoma Outreach Director, Carey Fabrizio. "I think it's really worked out. It's very functional, we have offices, a big warehouse, and even plans for future expansion with a walk-in cooler and freezer."

Serving up to 150 families per week, the CC McAlester runs so well thanks to the efforts of its dedicated volunteers. The McAlester team saw 1,931 unique clients just in the first four months of 2025. As of the printing of this newsletter, 28 volunteers gave 2,860 hours serving their neighbors.

Recently, volunteers gathered for two training sessions and enjoyed lunch together. The camaraderie of the volunteer team was evident. Dcn. Bill Anderson, a longtime McAlester volunteer, was also able to bless San Damiano crosses that were given out to all McAlester volunteers. (top right photo)

The work done by the staff of Catholic Charities is extremely important to the communities in Pittsburg County, where McAlester is located. Data indicates that over 18% of the residents in Pittsburg County live below the poverty level and 18% suffer from food insecurity.

The new facility includes a clothing center with racks of clothes, diapers for infants, baby clothes, shoes, and other assorted items. There is a well-organized food pantry where neighbors can shop for the food items they like and will eat, a kitchenette for volunteers and employees, as well as a conference room and a warehouse. There is ample parking and a fenced area where a CCEOK box truck parks when not on the road picking up or delivering food.
