

In addition to our Padre Pio Emergency Assistance services provided throughout the year, thousands of people are also served through Catholic Charities' seasonal programs. None of these services would be possible without the generosity and support of our area parishes, companies and individuals.

Last Thanksgiving, Catholic Charities was able to distribute 800 turkeys, produce, and other extras to the needy. This was possible due to large donations made by St. Bernard's Parish, coordinated by Deacon Richard Campbell, and TRC Disaster Solutions; each contributed 300 turkeys! The remainder of the turkeys were donated by Deacon Tom Gorman of Holy Family.
